1) **Announcements**

- Kroening Endowment – background and grant proposal program presented by Bodie. Projects approved by the BOD:
 - Summit Lake cutthroat trout preliminary assessment - \$5,175
 - PIT tag antenna at Catnip Reservoir - \$10,000 (funding pending results of coldwater bacteria confirmation)
 - Trout in the Classroom – Galena HS needs chiller for aquarium - \$700
 - California and Nevada Fishing Youth Camp at Sagehen Creek – June 15-17, 2012; funding for 2 years - \$1,250
 - Restoring Carson River watershed (Part II) – Cal Trout - \$8,500
 - Status assessment of Nevada's Native Fisheries – statewide literature search - \$5,400

Total request funding = \$31,025 (board approved)

Tier 1 at 4% funding = \$28,931

Tier 2 at 6% funding = \$43,397
