- Kroening Endowment background and grant proposal program presented by Bodie. Projects approved by the BOD:
  - o Summit Lake cutthroat trout preliminary assessment \$5,175
  - o PIT tag antenna at Catnip Reservoir \$10,000 (funding pending results of coldwater bacteria confirmation)
  - o Trout in the Classroom Galena HS needs chiller for aquarium \$700
  - California and Nevada Fishing Youth Camp at Sagehen Creek June 15-17, 2012;
     funding for 2 years \$1,250
  - o Restoring Carson River watershed (Part II) Cal Trout \$8,500
  - o Status assessment of Nevada's Native Fisheries statewide literature search \$5,400

Total request funding = \$31,025 (board approved)

Tier 2 at 6% funding = \$43,397
